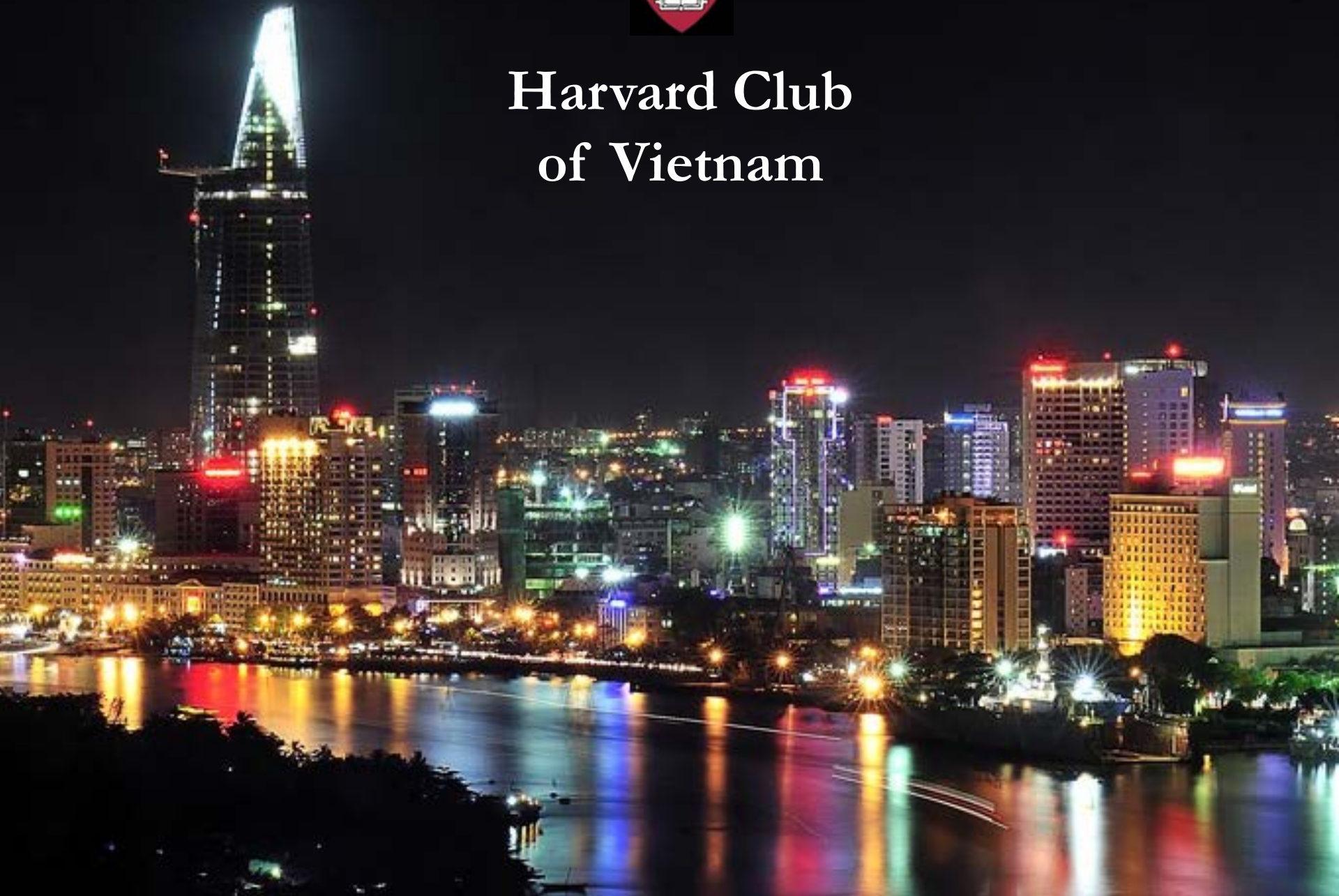

An Overview of Vietnam....

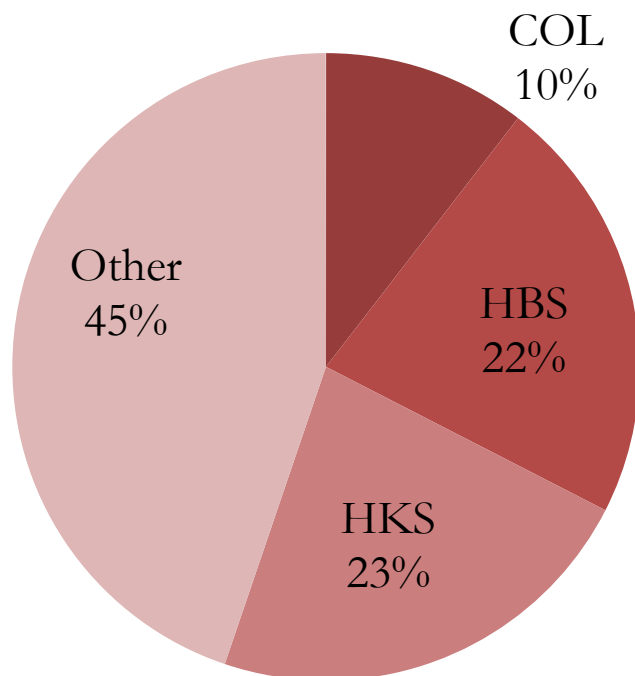


	The Country	The Alumni Club

Last Year and This Year

Programming:

- **From general networking to more value-add, e.g.:**
