 - . Serving as Club's management team, President and Board




Harvard Club of Russia: why members join

- 4. Get priority at events with limited capacity (keynote speakers, balls, etc.).




Harvard Club of Russia: growing fast, diversified between schools, mainly in Moscow

- -All Harvard Schools represented




- 500 in CIS (453+ only in Moscow)
- 170 abroad (USA, UK and Europe)






Harvard Club of Russia: 1/3 are women, 50% graduated recently

Harvard Club of Russia: Global Education Initiative

Global Education for Russians

- Club leadership took an active part in the structuring and promotion of the programme 'Global Education for Russians'
- Long way: In 2011, the Harvard Club of Russia organized a meeting with Andrey Fursenko, at that time the Minister of Education and Science and convinced him to support our initiative for establishing the first state-sponsored scholarship to educate Russian citizens at the leading world universities
- 2014 Prime Minister Medvedev signed on June 20 a decree to launch the Global Education for Russians
- The program envisages the establishment of a fund with contributions from the federal budget and state-owned companies to finance education for Russian students pursuing Ph.D. and master's degrees in leading foreign universities, and then to arrange their subsequent employment in Russian scientific educational centres, the state service, and in companies with state participation.
