Professor Sawyer will speak about her new book, *American Fair Trade, Proprietary Capitalism, Corporatism, and the 'New Competition,' 1890-1940*, as well as her recent HBS case on "Google in Europe: Competition Policy in the Digital Era." She looks forward to engaging conversation with Harvard alumni and guests.

Laura Phillips Sawyer is an assistant professor at Harvard Business School in the Business, Government, and International Economy Unit, where she teaches the course of the same name in the MBA required curriculum.

Professor Sawyer studies the history of capitalism in the United States, focusing on post-Civil War U.S. political economy. She explains how changes in legal theory, economic thought, and business methods influenced the emergence of various types of regulation—both seen and unseen—and shaped trends in American business organization and consumer culture. Her work has been published in the *Journal for the Gilded Age and Progressive Era* and *Business and Economic History*.
