Building on Harvard's historic ties with Central America through our many friends and alumni, a historic relationship with INCAE, and Laspau's work with many Central American universities, DRCLAS has assembled the following record in the region.

Hosted **22** Visiting Scholars either from Central America or on Central American topics, including US-Central American relations, history, remittances, politics and chocolate.



31 faculty members working on Central America in the fields of archeology, human rights, corruption and violence, commerce, and public health

15 graduate and undergraduate students dedicated to Central American studies, including the Zika virus, Mayan history, biodiversity, marketing, and politics.

In **2018** we are already planning a Central American film series, a seminar on health policy, a major event on the Honduran elections, ongoing work on immigration, and a Graduate School of Design course in Costa Rica.
