

Summer Community Service Fellowship (SCSF)

Sample Outreach Language to SCSF Fellows

Overview: This document provides sample language to engage with your SCSF fellows over the course of their fellowship. Use it as-is or customize it to fit your tone and available opportunities the Club/SIG wishes to extend to the students. Consider including additional details, such as upcoming events, relevant contacts, and important links to help fellows stay connected.

- Message 1: Brief Congratulatory and Welcome Message (April/May)
- Message 2: Detailed Congratulatory and Welcome Message (April/May)
- Message 3: Fellowship Kickoff Message (early June)
- Message 4: Invitation to Share Fellowship Experience with the Board (early August)

Important Notes:

- Clubs and SIGs may only contact SCSF fellows after being notified by the HAA Clubs and SIGs team that the fellow has accepted the funding offer.
- While we encourage Clubs and SIGs to invite fellows to connect, attend events, and share their experiences with your community (such as through a board presentation), participation in these activities is optional and not a requirement of the program.
- For any questions regarding the fellowship itself, students should contact the staff at the Center for Public Service and Engaged Scholarship (CPSES).
