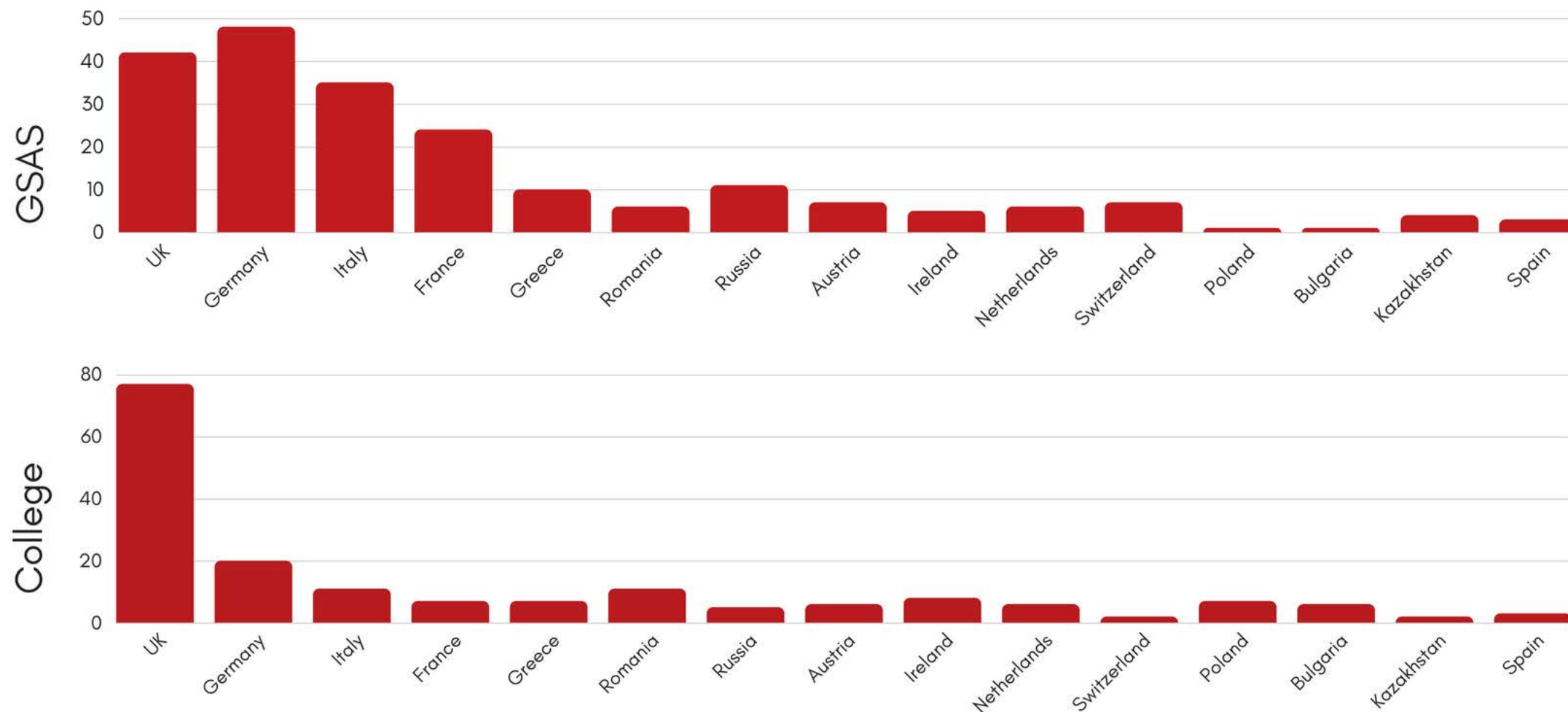


Recent FAS Events & Initiatives
