	 We reached out to ca 10.000 students via personal presentations and social media, nationwide
	 Ca 1000 applications were submitted, dozens of students were interviewed, 30 laureates, including 4 top prize winners, were selected
	In June the awards were announced at a Gala at the Royal Castle, covered in social media
	In October, the 4 top prize winners visited Harvard, with all expenses covered by our Club
