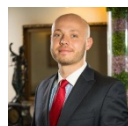

## Projects - Accomplishments

### VIII Edition of Path to Harvard Competition

- The Competition is organized to encourage high school students to apply to Harvard College and university students to apply to Harvard graduate programs
- We reached out to ca 10.000 students via personal presentations and social media, nationwide
- Ca 1000 applications were submitted, dozens of students were interviewed, 30 laureates, including 4 top prize winners, were selected
- In June the awards were announced at a Gala at the Royal Castle, covered in social media
- In October, the 4 top prize winners visited Harvard, with all expenses covered by our Club

### Meetings on politics, technology, and cultural events

- Meetings with politicians and public officials, including a former President of Poland, Mr Bronisław Komorowski, and a former Chairman of Constitutional Tribunal, Prof. Andrzej Rzepliński
- Meetings with technology players, including a head of Government Innovation Fund and a founder of a block chain company
- Going out to theaters, opera, concert halls, and a wine tasting event

### Cooperation with other clubs of European and US universities

- We organized meetings to which we invited members of other clubs, including
  - a meeting at the Free Speech Memorial in Warsaw, together with Columbia, MIT, Stanford, Yale, INSEAD and Oxford/Cambridge clubs, with an honorary guest, President Bronisław Komorowski
  - a lecture of Dr Marcin Piątkowski, former Visiting Scholar at Harvard University's Center for European Studies, on his new book *Europe's Growth Champion. Insights from the Economic Rise of Poland*, attended by ca 100 members of Polish clubs of graduates of leading European and US universities
